

Instructions

1. Print this file on to an overhead transparency film sheet. You should print directly onto the transparency sheet, and not use a photocopier, as a photocopier may change the scale.
2. Check that the printing process has not affected the scale. The large rectangle in the bottom half of the protractor (the 1:25,000 eight figure roamer) should measure exactly 80 mm X 40 mm.
3. Make holes at the locations of the small circles on the sheet as required for your evaluation. This is best done by heating up a pin or similar object, and melting these through the sheet.
4. Use the evaluation copy of the protractor as described in the instruction sheet.
5. Once you are satisfied that the GPS Plotting Protractor performs as specified, simply contact us to purchase a production version.
